



8. Improve quality of life for older people




HOW DID WE PLAN OUR PENDLE, OUR FUTURE?


We looked at the key issues for Pendle

- Have busy town centres
- Improve housing so it meets your needs and is affordable
- Create more employment opportunities
- Encourage different communities to get on well
- Promote health awareness
- Improve the cleanliness of our streets and neighbourhoods
- Help improve public transport and roads
- Create more facilities for young people
- Help to raise standards in education
- Make sure older people can access good health, homes and neighbourhoods

WHAT WE'LL DO*:

- Provide opportunities for people of different backgrounds to work and play together
- Increase the number of working age adults in work
- Increase the number of 16-18 year olds in education, training and jobs
- Reduce the number of empty properties in Pendle
- Reduce anti-social behaviour and crime
- Improve street cleanliness
- Reduce infant mortality
- Reduce alcohol and drugs misuse
- Give children and young people the opportunity to take part in activities, including play, leisure and sport
- Raise standards in schools in our deprived wards
- Reduce the impact of poverty on the health of our children and young people
- Improve the health and emotional wellbeing of older people
