

# SPD Adoption Statement



Planning and Compulsory Purchase Act 2004

Regulation 19(a)ii

Town and Country Planning (Local Development) (England) (Amendment) Regulations 2009

In accordance with Regulation 19 (a)(ii) of the Town and Country Planning (Local Development) (England) (Amendment) Regulations 2009, this statement gives notice that Pendle Borough Council formally adopted a Supplementary Planning Document (SPD) entitled **Design Principles** on 10<sup>th</sup> December 2009.

Any person aggrieved by the SPD may apply to the High Court for permission to apply for judicial review of the decision to adopt the SPD. Any such application for leave must be made promptly and in any event not later than 3 months after the date on which the SPD was adopted.

The adopted SPD and consultation statement (Regulation 18 (4)b) will be available for public inspection on the Council's website and at the locations and times set out below.
