Pendle Core Strategy Examination: Schedule of Proposed Additional Modifications

Following a representation made by English Heritage (now Historic England) on the soundness of the Pendle Core Strategy with regards the historic environment, a meeting was held in January 2015 to discuss the way forward. It was agreed that a number of amendments were needed to the proposed Plan and these were finalised by email following the meeting.

English Heritage (now Historic England) has considered the proposed modifications put forward and agrees with the proposed changes and that they reflect those discussed and agreed with the Council.

Regarding the strategic housing land site allocation – heritage assessment. English Heritage (now Historic England) supports the proposal to include the heritage assessment undertaken to inform the proposed strategic housing site allocation as an additional appendix to the Core Strategy.

In view of the above, subject to the proposed modifications being agreed by the Inspector, English Heritage (now Historic England) will withdraw (conditionally) our objections to the Pendle Core Strategy.
