Petitions may also be presented.



AGENDA

1. Declaration of Interests

Members are reminded of the legal requirements concerning the declaration of interests.

A Member must declare a disclosable pecuniary interest which he/she has in any item on the agenda. A Member with a disclosable pecuniary interest in any item may not participate in any discussion of the matter at the meeting and must not participate in any vote taken on the matter at the meeting.

In addition the Council's Standing Orders require a Member with a disclosable pecuniary interest to leave the room where the meeting is held while any discussion or voting takes place."

The Law Commission is undertaking a reform on the Law of Taxis and Private Hire Vehicles and one of their suggestions is that all drivers will be required to have disability awareness training to deal with people with disabilities.

RECOMMENDATION

That this item be deferred until the draft bill and final proposals on Reforming the Law of Taxis and Private Hire Services have been published in November 2013.

7. <u>Vehicle Application</u>

Enc. The Engineering and Special Projects Manager submits that attached report which asks members to consider when an application for a hackney carriage or private hire vehicle licence should be treated as a new application once the renewal date has passed.
