	down by 24% in December 2015 compared with the year before. There is				
	concern at the lack of understanding amongst young people in the community

	that there is sometimes a lack of communication between the Council and the				
	Youth Groups in terms of how policies and decisions may affect young people.				
	It is therefore felt that it is important to encourage as many young people as				
	possible to engage in the democratic process.
