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# Former Marsden Cross, 30 Higher Reedley Road, Brierfield, Nelson BB9 5HA

### PURPOSE OF REPORT

As requested by the Committee with regard to the possibility of adding the site to the Problem Buildings list.

#### ISSUES

The site is a former public house which was granted planning permission for conversion into four flats in 2012. This permission has now expired.

The property is an attractive detached stone built building in a prominent location within Brierfield.

A site visit has been made by a Planning Officer and it was noted that the building has been vacant for some time. Many of the ground and first floor windows are broken and some are boarded up.

It appears that there has been a fire internally as some of the first floor windows are gone and the stone surrounds and timber frames are charred.

Given the condition of the building, its vacant state, prominent position and that no works have taken place to improve the appearance of the building the property should be added to the problem buildings list and the owner contacted and requested to carry out improvements and repairs to the building.

A large freestanding timber sign has also been positioned on the site without consent and should be removed.

Details of the owner have been obtained and contact made. Any update will be reported to the meeting.
