- Notice is hereby given the Borough Council of Pendle ("the Council") has extended and varied the above Public Spaces Protection Order under Section 60 of the Anti-Social Behaviour, Crime and Policing Act 2014 ("the Act") operative from 28<sup>th</sup> January 2022.
- 2. The effect of the Order is to impose the prohibitions and restrictions detailed in Schedules 1 and 2 to the Order and which prohibitions and restrictions shall apply to all persons at all times of the day and night throughout the entirety of the land to which the Order applies.
- 3. The Order contains certain exemptions for people with disabilities as set out in Clause 8 of the Order.

- Anybody wishing to question the Order's provisions or validity may apply to the High Court for this purpose within six weeks from the date the order was legally made being 28<sup>th</sup> January 2022
