Colne Neighbourhood Plan: Response to Clarification Note

Thank you for sending us a copy of your Clarification Note.

Please find below our answers to the questions you have asked Pendle Borough Council to answer.

1. Is there an update on the emerging master plan for the Town Centre?

The Colne Masterplan is one of three currently in preparation for Pendle. All are in the early stages of preparation.

The first draft of the Baseline Document was received from consultants OPEN in December 2022. The Council is in the process of feeding back to OPEN on the content of these documents.

Once the Baseline Document for Colne is finalised, OPEN will consider the data and any public feedback they have received. They will then explore a range of different options for the town and recommend what they consider to be the best option for transforming the town centre.

2. Is the work on the new Local Plan still proceeding to the timetable included in the Local Development Scheme (May 2022)?

The timetable from the current Local Development Scheme (LDS) is copied overleaf for ease of reference:

The Regulation 18 public consultation, to consider the Pendle Local Plan (Preferred Options Report) will be delayed until late May / early June 2023. This is due to a combination of factors including a delay in receiving evidence base documents from our consultants, the local elections and the Coronation of King Charles III.
