GENERAL

All drawings and must contain a drawing title, drawing number and revision numbers. All documents must be referenced. Drawings must show previous extensions and calculations of volumes for applications if the site is within the green belt. All plans and drawings should include: paper size, key dimensions and scale bar indicating a minimum of 0-10 metres

LOCATION PLAN

All applications must include copies of a location plan based on an up-to-date map. This should be at a scale of 1:1250 or 1:2500. In exceptional circumstances plans of other scales may also be required. Plans should wherever possible show at least two named roads and surrounding buildings. The properties shown should be numbered or named to ensure that the exact location of the application site is clear. The plan should be marked with a north point and identify a minimum of two roads. We will also accept any location plans downloaded from Planning Portal www.planningportal.gov.uk.

PLANNING STATEMENT

A planning statement identifies the context and need for a proposed development and includes an assessment of how the proposed development accords with relevant national, regional and local planning policies.
