## **GUIDANCE NOTES**

## **GENERAL**

All drawings and must contain a drawing title, drawing number and revision numbers. All documents must be referenced. All plans and drawings should include: paper size, key dimensions and scale bar indicating a minimum of 0-10 metres.

## **LOCATION PLAN**

All applications must include copies of a location plan based on an up-to-date map. This should be at a scale of 1:1250 or 1:2500. In exceptional circumstances plans of other scales may also be required. Plans should wherever possible show at least two named roads and surrounding buildings. The properties shown should be numbered or named to ensure that the exact location of the application site is clear. The application site should be edged clearly with a red line. It should include all land necessary to carry out the proposed development. A blue line should be drawn around any other land owned by the applicant, close to or adjoining the application site.

The plan should be marked with a north point and identify a minimum of two roads. We will also accept any location plans downloaded from Planning Portal www.planningportal.gov.uk.
