


NATIONAL ROAD RACE ROUTE 2010 BARLEY - IN REVERSE



DISTANCE
7.3 MILE LOOP | **800** FEET OF ASCENT



#01
START



#3 Pass the statue of Alice Nutter on your left at 1.5 miles and continue to the long climb up to Gisburn Road.



#4 Caution at the junction 2.8 miles, turn left and then immediate left. Down a steep descent Wheathead Lane.



#1 Start at Barley Picnic site, turning left out of the car park.



#2 Descend into Roughlee and turn left towards Blacko at 1 mile.



#5 A long steady climb to the top at 4.7 miles giving panoramic views of Pendle and the Ribble Valley.



#6 Continue to the cross roads at 5.6 miles. Turn left down back to Barley and the finish, care required on the descent with a combination of poor road surface and steep narrow lanes.
