**Submission**

Notice is hereby given in accordance with the above regulations that Pendle Borough Council submitted its Core Strategy DPD to the Secretary of State for independent Examination on Friday 19<sup>th</sup> December 2014.

**Examination**

The Examination is a continuous process running from the date of submission through to receipt of the Inspector's Report.

The Secretary of State has appointed Inspector Mr. Mark Dakeyne BA (Hons) MRTPI to oversee the Examination of the Core Strategy DPD.

Anyone who has sought changes to the Core Strategy DPD and indicated their wish to be heard will be invited to attend a hearing session.

**(a) Programme Officer**

A Programme Officer has been appointed by Pendle Borough Council to deal with all administrative, procedural and programming matters associated with the Examination. The Programme Officer is not a Council Officer, has not been involved in the preparation of the Core Strategy and works solely to the direction of the Inspector.
