This adoption statement has been prepared in accordance with Regulation 24(2) and Regulation 36 of the Town and Country Planning (Local Development) (England) (Amendment) Regulations 2008, and gives notice that the Bradley Area Action Plan (AAP) produced by the Borough of Pendle was formally adopted on 30th June 2011.

The Bradley AAP sets out the Council's planning framework to guide the future development and regeneration of the Bradley area of Nelson. The document forms part of the emerging Local Development Framework for Pendle.
