- The incentive is open to anyone who owns or lives in a property in Pendle and is subscribed to the Garden Waste Subscription service for 2017/18 before 31st July 2017.
- Entrants must be over 18 years of age.
- Names will be made by random selection at 12pm 7th August 2017
- The winners will be notified by Pendle Council by email or phone within 14 days of the draw.
- Any entrant who has an unspent criminal record or anti-social behaviour order or has unpaid council tax will be ineligible and an alternative prize winner will be drawn.
- Two further names will also be picked to create a substitute pool should the first and second winners not come forward or be ineligible. The two substitute winners will be first alternative winner and second alternative winner.
- If the winners do not confirm acceptance of the prize within 30 days, or if it is found that either of the winners are ineligible, then that winner will be considered to have forfeited the tidy-up and Pendle Council will be entitled to contact the first alternative winner. The first alternative winner shall have 14 days from notification to confirm their acceptance of the tidy-up by phone, letter or email.
