Refurbishment of Building on Higham Playing Fields

The building is situated near the top of Higham Playing Field.

It is next to the 12ft right of way, which forms the boundary with the new, recently completed Clover Croft Development.

At the other side of the building is the refurbished Children's Playground, which was extended and brought up to present day standards with money from s106 of the planning consent for the Clover Croft development.

The building is in a disreputable state and detracts from the new development and the shiny new playground on either side.

The building is at present used for storage of items belonging to Higham Parish Council and Higham Events Committee.

Unfortunately, recently, children have been seen climbing on to the building and adjacent walls, causing damage, but more importantly putting themselves in danger of injury.

This project is urgently required from a Health and Safety point of view as well as from a cosmetic and practical viewpoint.

It is proposed that Higham Parish Council spend £10,000 on the refurbishment of this building. This will include repairs to the roof and walls, new doors and windows and a new concrete floor inside, as well as external landscaping.

The use will continue as storage, but in the future the use may change as the Playing Field use changes.

The amount requested for capital funding from Pendle Borough Council is £5,000. This will be match funded by Higham Parish Council, to make up the £10,000 projected spend.

It is proposed to use a local approved contractor and implement the works as soon as the specification of works is completed and contractor quotations approved.
