## 10. PERFORMANCE INDICATOR (PI) REPORT – 1<sup>st</sup> APRIL – 31<sup>st</sup> DECEMBER 2014

The Head of Central and Regeneration Services submitted a report which provided the Panel with details of performance for the period 1<sup>st</sup> April, 2013 to 31<sup>st</sup> December, 2014. It was reported that of the 83 measurable Pls 49 (59%) were performing on or above target whilst 41% were underperforming (24 (29%) were red and 10 (12%) were amber). The report outlined that performance had generally deteriorated since the last report. There were 4 Pls that performed well on quarters 1 and 2 which showed an underperformance that were detailed in appendix 1 of

the report. The Head of Central and Regeneration Service reported that on a positive note 3 PIs that were underperforming during previous quarters were now on target. These were:

AP3 - % of PIs reported that were activated in Covalent before agreed deadlines

AP4 - % of Council Taxpayers paying by DD

WM3 - Number of FPN's issued

4 PIs had already exceeded the target for the year by the end of Quarter 2. As a result Management Team agreed that the original targets be reviewed and increased appropriately.
