10. The Smoke and Carbon Monoxide Alarm (England) Regulations 2015

- “(1) That the Housing, Health and Economic Development Services Manager be authorised to exercise the Council’s full enforcement powers under the “Smoke and Carbon Monoxide Alarm (England) Regulations 2015” made under Section 150(1)-(6) and (10) of the energy Act 2013 and paragraph 3(a) of Schedule 4 to the Housing Act 2004 that came into force on 1st October, 2015.
- (2) That the statement of principles which the Local Authority will follow in determining the amount of a penalty charge related to a breach of the Smoke and Carbon Monoxide Alarm (England) Regulations 2015 be approved.
- (3) That the Council’s Private Sector Housing Enforcement Policy be amended to include the new regulations.”
