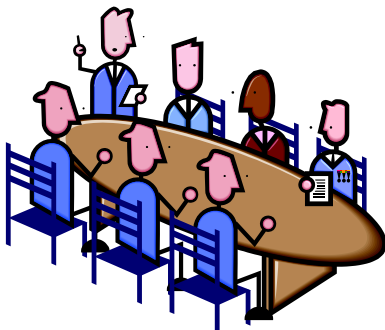
# **HEALTH AND SOCIAL CARE SCRUTINY PANEL**
