Harrison Drive, Colne

In terms of grounds maintenance, it costs us £2,257.57 to maintain the recreation ground on an annual basis.

Please note – Harrison Drive has not been used for any organised Sports fixtures for approximately 10 years. In the last 3-4 years, maintenance has been minimal although the site is litter picked on a weekly basis. There are no plans from PBC to bring this site back in to use as a Sports venue.

There is no revenue budget associated with Harrison Drive.

There are other implications/issues that Colne Town Council will need to be aware of in terms of managing/maintaining the site if the land is transferred in to their ownership. These are:

- Dealing with general issues and complaints relating to the Recreation Ground, e.g. vandalism.
- Public Space Protection Order's (PSPO's) to uphold ensuring the Recreation Ground is used appropriately and in line with the PSPO (which is scheduled to come in to operation by the end of March 2017 and will include most things previously in the Bye-Laws plus dog control, fouling, etc.)
