	6 parking permits would be issued for use by District Nurses on the Health Centre car park. 6 parking permits would be issued for other medical staff on the Health Centre car park. 20 dispensations would be issued for use on the Red Lion Street car park for medical staff only. The Health Centre was to decide who would qualify for these dispensations.	All parking permits and dispensations have been issued.
