**PROGRESS REPORT ON ACTION ARISING FROM
 COLNE AND DISTRICT COMMITTEE ON 31st MARCH, 2016**

1.	<p><u>Progress Report</u></p> <p>The Chairman provided an update following a meeting with representatives from Colne Health Centre regarding parking issues in that area. Following discussions it had been agreed that:</p> <p>6 parking permits would be issued for use by District Nurses on the Health Centre car park. 6 parking permits would be issued for other medical staff on the Health Centre car park. 20 dispensations would be issued for use on the Red Lion Street car park for medical staff only. The Health Centre was to decide who would qualify for these dispensations. This was in addition to the 4 Health Centre bays that were on a private section of the Red Lion car park.
