## **RESULTS OF APPEALS/PROSECUTIONS**

### **PURPOSE OF REPORT**

To report, for information, the results of appeals/prosecutions since the last meeting.

### **APPEALS**

#### **1. Alkhiam Ali – appeal against revocation of his private hire driver’s licence**

Appeal heard at Burnley Magistrates’ Court on 22 April 2016. The appeal was dismissed as the district judge was not convinced of his honesty, reliability or suitability to hold a licence. Ali was ordered to pay £350 contribution to the Council’s costs.

### **IMPLICATIONS**

**Policy:** An appeal can be lodged to the Magistrates’ Court against a decision to refuse, renew, suspend or revoke a licence or any conditions attached to a licence.
