A very quiet month for crimes, which is always nice.

One **dwelling burglary** at Wheatley Springs estate, during the day, but nothing stolen as this was only an attempt to force a window and no entry was actually gained.

Four **thefts** relate to 3 x shopliftings from Booths (2) and Morrisons (1). The Booths offences was actually 10 separate incidents (only noticed when he was arrested for one offence), committed by an out of town, professional shoplifter. He has been arrested and charged

with these matters. The second shoplifting was an associate of the first offender who was identified and dealt with by a penalty notice. Morrisons shoplifter was identified and will be dealt with in the near future. Again, an out of town offender.

Only other offence was a **theft** of stone wall top stones.

Criminal damages – not connected and all separate types of damage.

Burglary non-dwelling. Theft of stone from Bay Horse pub whilst under renovation. Theft of pedal cycle from garage of house, Higherford.

Drugs – Car stopped in secluded car park and occupants found with several wraps of heroin. Suspects are from Nelson and pending a charging decision.
