BRIEFING NOTES RE WORK PROGRAMME 2016/17

Background

1. At this, the first scheduled meeting of the new Council year, the Panel should consider what issues to include in its work programme for the next 12 months.
2. Clearly there will be a need for flexibility so that any emerging issues which require the Panel's attention can be accommodated.
3. Some of the issues taken up by the Panel during 2015/16 require further monitoring and will need to be brought forward into the current programme.
4. Additionally, the Panel has been asked to monitor Pendle's Action Plans on Health and Wellbeing; Dementia Action Alliance; and Ageing Well.

Current Position

5. It is suggested that the following issues which were addressed by the Panel during the course of the last Council year should continue to be monitored. Updates on some of these issues are elsewhere on the agenda –
 - Adult Social Care – Recommissioning of Homecare Services
 - Fracture Clinic
 - Eye Care Provision
6. Last year's monitoring of an earlier review of District Nurse Provision led to the Panel receiving information on the implementation of Integrated Care provided by the East Lancashire Hospitals Trust (ELHT) and East Lancashire Clinical Commissioning Group (ELCCG).
7. This was implemented in September, 2015 and Members may wish to continue to receive updates during 2016/17.

8. Members should also decide whether the Panel should continue to receive updates on the work of North West Ambulance Service, alongside the regular monitoring being carried out by West Craven Committee.
9. In light of the above, a draft work programme is appended to this briefing note for discussion, amendment and final approval
