9. Verge Cutting

Following the request at the last meeting the Neighbourhood Services Manager reports that Pendle BC cuts the verges on the A6068 from Junction 13 to Carr Hall Rd. Pendle BC carry out 8 cuts per year on this section through the Highways Partnership with LCC (funding heavily subsidised by Pendle BC).

LCC are responsible for cutting the verges beyond Carr Hall Road (indications from LCC are that verge maintenance will be minimal e.g. 2 cuts per year on all verges that they are directly responsible for cutting).
