Brief details of Project: The bus shelter at Dickie Nook was subject to a delayed transfer due to structural issues and during this interim period has suffered additional damage from an unidentified vehicle. The additional damage sustained left Pendle BC with no option but to demolish the shelter. Barrowford Parish Council recently acquired a bus shelter and has offered it as a replacement as no funding is available at Pendle BC to pay for a replacement or installation costs.

Due to the open nature of the surroundings at Dickie Nook a shelter is essential during the winter for the comfort of bus users this works need to be carried out over the next few weeks and given that once installed future maintenance costs will fall on the Barrowford Parish Council a request for funding towards the installation costs is not unreasonable.

Main Outcomes to be Achieved: Improved weather protection to bus service users

When will Project be implemented? Within the next few weeks as soon as the contractor is available.

Who will undertake the Project works? The work will be carried out by the Contractor Pendle Borough Council has used in the past for similar works.
