10. Local Plan Part 2

At the Executive on 17th November 2016, Members were informed of the progress on the preparation of the Pendle Local Plan Part 2. It was agreed that a cross-party Working Group be established to consider the strategic development of the plan. The first meeting of this group has now been held with the key issues and timetable for the preparation of the plan being discussed.

Also at the Executive, a draft report setting out the scope of the plan (i.e. the issues and policies it will cover – including the amount of housing to be developed in each settlement) and a methodology for the assessment of sites was presented, together with a report on the Green

Belt Assessment. It was agreed that these documents would form part of a public consultation. Since the Executive an additional document, the Sustainability Appraisal Scoping Report, has been drafted and will also form part of the consultation.

Members should note that the public consultation on these documents and an additional call for sites will begin in mid-February (dates to be confirmed) and will run for a period of six weeks. This consultation will provide the community and other interested parties with an opportunity to comment on, and shape the direction of, the Local Plan Part 2.
