12. Wesley Street, Brierfield – request for double yellow lines

In response to a request from this Committee, Lancashire County Council (LCC) advise that it is unable to support the introduction of kerbside waiting restrictions on Wesley Street, Brierfield at its junction with Colne Road at the current time.

In addition to carrying out schemes that contribute to the improvement of the wider highway network, LCC's current priority is to target resources at locations with a proven road safety issue. As there are currently no collisions recorded in this location in the previous five year period, this request is not considered a priority.
