BRIEFING NOTE RE. WORK PROGRAMME 2017/18

Background

1. At this, the first scheduled meeting of the new Council year, the Panel should consider what issues to include in its work programme for the next 12 months.
2. Clearly there will be a need for flexibility so that any emerging issues which require the Panel's attention can be accommodated.
3. Some of the issues taken up by the Panel during 2016/17 require further monitoring and will need to be brought forward into the current programme.
4. Additionally, the Panel will continue to monitor Pendle's Action Plans on Health and Wellbeing; Dementia Action Alliance; and Older People.

Current Position

5. It is suggested that the following issues which were addressed by the Panel during the course of the last Council year should continue to be monitored. Updates on some of these issues are elsewhere on the agenda –
 - Lancashire and South Cumbria Sustainability and Transformation Plan
 - Adult Social Care – Recommissioning of Homecare Services
6. New topics for consideration include –
 - Highlighting the symptoms of Sepsis
 - Publicity re. organ donation
7. In recent years, the Panel has continued to receive updates on progress with Integrated Care provided by the East Lancashire Hospitals Trust (ELHT) and East

Lancashire Clinical Commissioning Group (ELCCG) which was implemented in September, 2015.

8. Members should now decide whether they would like to continue receiving updates on this service.
9. Last year the Panel was also involved in an NHS consultation on proposals to improve access to GP services.
10. The Panel may wish to consider requesting six monthly or annual updates on this topic.
11. In light of the above, a draft work programme is appended to this briefing note for discussion, amendment and final approval
