SCRUTINY REVIEW OF DRUG AND ALCOHOL REHABILITATION PROVISION IN EAST LANCASHIRE - UPDATE

Background

- 1. In 2016/17 the Health and Social Care Scrutiny Panel carried out a review of drug and alcohol rehabilitation provision in East Lancashire.
- 2. The Panel's work included considering information from a number of organisations that carry out vital work around early intervention and prevention, and provide help for those that require help in breaking free from drug, alcohol and other addictions.
- 3. One such organisation is Inspire Integrated Substance Misuse Service (East Lancashire) who deliver an adult treatment service in the area.
- 4. Inspire are leaders in adapting the Community Delivery Model of working and a list of community venues is provided in the final report of the Panel, which can be accessed via the following link http://www.pendle.gov.uk/info/20093/overview_and_scrutiny/224/scrutiny/4
- 5. This list is subject to change and Inspire are keen to keep the Panel updated on any changes.

Update

- 6. In addition to the venues listed in the Panel's final report, Inspire are now working out of Grassroots Centre at St Phillips, Leeds Road, Nelson, with staff based there from Monday to Friday.
- 7. Various rooms in the building are used, including office space and rooms used for 1-1 appointments, group work programmes, open access and assessments, family support and service user led groups.

- 8. They link up with existing services at Grassroots and, from mid-May 2017, they have also delivered healthcare and medical appointments from the Centre.
- 9. Inspire also plan to utilise space being converted at Open Door Café in Colne and have been in discussion with the team there on linking up services to offer a range of 1-1 and group services.
- 10. In addition, they also have a member of staff working out of a number of health centres on a weekly/fortnightly basis in Barnoldswick, Earby, Nelson and Colne.
