Brief details of Project:

The Group came together with the Aim of keeping Salterforth Toilets open after they were closed by Pendle Council. Our current aim is to keep the toilets open as long as possible but only if we have the money to fund them in advance. We are again looking for funding to help us with a broken Sewage pipe. We had managed to clear the blockage several time but each time the challenge got harder until we finally had to enlist help of a drain specialist which cost £250. They cleared the drain but found the fault to be a collapsed pipe and the fault would reoccur without it being replaced. They gave us a quote of £1500. Unfortunately that would just about clean us out but our Goal is to keep the Toilets open as long as possible.

Main Outcomes to be Achieved:

To repair the pipe and keep the Disabled and Female Toilets open without impacting on next years funding.
