#### 13. Earby Cricket Club – Terms of Licence

Following discussions at the last meeting, the Council's Licensing Enforcement Officer met with two members of Earby Cricket Club Committee on 13th July.

He gave advice on how to reduce noise i.e. keeping doors and windows closed during regulated entertainment, transferring the music from outside to inside once the 20/20 cricket had finished (around 9pm) and erecting posters asking patrons to leave the premises quietly. Hopefully this will help to eradicate the noise issues or reduce them to an acceptable level.

The club doesn't have any authorisations on the licence for either live or recorded music. However since the introduction of the Live Music Act in 2012 permission for such entertainment is no longer required in licensed premises between the hours of 08.00 and 23.00 providing that no more than 500 people are present.

The club is allowed to sell alcohol as follows;

- Monday to Saturday 10.00 to 23.00
- Sunday 12.00 to 22.30

There are seasonal time variations on the licence in relation to Easter, Christmas, New Year etc.

Should there be any further complaints in relation to noise, the Council's Environmental Health Noise Team can be contacted via the Council's website.
