Back Macleod and back Milton Street both have adopted and unadopted highway sections. Clarification for which sections are being referred to has been requested, but no response has been received as yet.

Back Victoria Street is an adopted highway, the following response was received by LCC Highways regarding back Victoria Street, along with a few other adopted sections of the highway –

“We have now inspected the back streets identified and don't consider any action is currently required. We are therefore unable to identify defects that meet an actionable level at this time, although we have identified a need to replace a gully lid & frame at the rear of 10 Hereford Street”.
