HIGHWAY MATTERS

9. <u>Traffic Calming Measures, Borrowdale Drive, Reedley</u>

In response to requests from this Committee and local residents, Lancashire County Council (LCC), along with Pendle Borough Council (PBC), has investigated the request to consider highway improvements on Borrowdale Drive, Reedley.

It is reported that, at a meeting with LCC and partners it was agreed that no further action be taken. The community concern and the suggestions put forward have been considered, but as the road/route has a very good road safety history, with no collisions currently recorded, the County Council has stated that it is unable to justify any further investigations.

PBC will raise the matter again at the next Pendle Traffic Liaison Meeting.

MISCELLANEOUS MATTERS

10. Environmental Crime

11. Former Mansfield School Site – drainage issues

Further to a request from this Committee, Lancashire County Council has carried out two inspections of the former Mansfield School site to investigate reports of drainage issues. It was noted that there was some water coming off the site but was not thought to be of sufficient quantity to flow up over the kerb and into the nearby houses.

At present it is felt that there is no justification for undertaking any drainage works. However, LCC will continue to monitor the situation.
