Brief details of Project: Provision and maintenance of red grit bins in Brierfield and Reedley. The committee currently has 30 grit bins:

- 1. King's Causeway, Reedley (just below the Golf Club entrance)
- 2. King's Causeway, Reedley (Opposite Horncliffe Heights)
- 3. King's Causeway, Reedley (junction with Weatherhill Crescent)
- 4. 290 King's Causeway, Reedley
- 5. Hillsbrough Avenue, Brierfield
- 6. Marsden Drive, Brierfield (junction with Edge End Avenue)
- 7. Opposite 23 Pennine Way, Reedley
- 8. Heyhead Street/Coronation Road, Brierfield
- 9. 145 Halifax Road, Brierfield
- 10. Outside 50 Mansfield Crescent, Brierfield
- 11. Chapel Street (near Limefield Avenue junction), Brierfield
- 12. Stanley Street, Brierfield (junction with Castle Street)
- 13. Opposite 45 Stanley Street, Brierfield
- 14. Health Centre, Arthur Street, Brierfield
- 15. Outside 49 Walter Street, Brierfield
- 16. Bird Street, Brierfield
- 17. Outside Mosque, Bridge Street, Brierfield
- 18. Outside Church, Guilford Street Brierfield
- 19. Clitheroe Road, Brierfield (opposite side of road to Wood Clough Platts)
- 20. Clitheroe Road, Brierfield (adjacent Railway pub)
- 21. Quaker Bridge, Corner Hill Street, Off Montford Road, Reedley
- 22. Holden Road, Brierfield
- 23. Top of Reedley Road, Reedley (junction with Higher Reedley Road)
- 24. Reedley Road, Reedley (junction with Meadow Close)
- 25. Outside 22 Meadow Close, Reedley
- 26. Eagley Road, Brierfield
- 27. Reedley Drive, Reedley (junction of No. 25 through access to Sports Ground)
- 28. Borrowdale Drive, Reedley (junction Rydal Close)

- 29. Eskdale Close, Reedley
- 30. Stoneyhurst Height, Brierfield

In addition to maintaining 30 bins the following has been requested:

2 Replacement Bins

Outside Mosque, Bridge Street – Bin is full of water due to damage therefore cannot refill with grit.

Outside 22 Meadow Close, Reedley – Bin ruined and filling with water, therefore cannot refill with grit.

2 Additional Bins:

Clarkson Avenue, next to Reedley Court - around house number 47. Ravens Grove, off Meadow Close - around house number 21.

Request for bin to be moved:

There has been a request to move the grit bin from outside 333 Kings Causeway and relocate across from the property.

Funding is required to deal with these requests and the continued maintenance of all the bins. Breakdown of costs: New/replacement bin - £110 each Grit - £20 per fill Labour - £9.16 per bin (There are also admin costs)

To maintain the 30 bins currently in-situ it costs **£875** each time they are filled. If the committee is to continue with the provision and maintenance of red grit bins it will need to allocate money from its capital programme. There is no PBC revenue budget for this as gritting and grit bins are LCC responsibilities.
