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Brierfield Premises Improvement Grants

PURPOSE OF REPORT

To report to the Committee on grants under the Brieffield Premises Improvement Scheme.

RECOMMENDATIONS

- 1. That the Committee releases £3,000 formally awarded for improvements to 120 Halifax Road, Brierfield, subject to planning permission, on 04/07/17.
- 2. That the Committee continues with its decision making on Premises Improvement Grants as a standing item on the agenda.

REASONS FOR RECOMMENDATIONS

- 1. To allow payment to be made to the applicant.
- 2. To allow members to carry on taking decisions on Premises Improvement Grants as and when they appear.

ISSUE

1. Premises Improvement Grant scheme: Applications received in financial year 2017-18

In February 2017 a Premises Improvement Grant of £3000 was offered to ECO World Energy Ltd of 76-78 Colne Road, Brierfield. The signage work was completed in June 2017 and payment made to them.

Subsequently the following applications for grant assistance were received:

(i) Applicant: Farhat Khaliq Beauty Salon (PAID)
Address: 7 Burnley Road, Brierfield BB9 5HX

Project: New signage and lighting, as well as new doors and windows.

Planning

Permission already approved. Cost: £4795

Total Grant: £2397.50 (50%)

(ii) Applicant: Jamil Ahmed T/A Hillstop mini-market (PENDING)

Address: 120 Halifax Rd, Brierfield BB9 5BQ

Project: Replacing existing shop front and shutters. Application required

Planning Permission.

Cost: £6,000. Total Grant: £3000

The following was resolved by the Committee (Minutes 04.07.17):

42. BRIERFIELD TOWN CENTRE PREMISES IMPROVEMENT GRANTS

RESOLVED

- (1) That a grant of £2397.50 be awarded to Farhat Khaliq Beauty Salon for improvements to 7 Burnley Road, Brierfield.
- (2) That a grant of £3,000 be awarded to Jamil Ahmed T/A Hillstop Mini-market for improvements to 120 Halifax Road, Brierfield, subject to appropriate planning permission being in place.

REASON

- 2. Results of 2017-18 approvals and future funding for 2018-19
 - (i) Farhat Khaliq completed the work on her beauty salon on Burnley Road, creating three new jobs.
 - (ii) Jamil Ahmed received planning permission on 25th September 2017 for his premises improvements and approached the Council again in early March 2018. The offer of the £3,000 grant was sent out to him on 20th March 2018.
 - (iii) An Officer from the Economic Development Team will continue to respond to requests from businesses in Brierfield for assistance, and seek on-going approval from the Committee for any requests for Premises Improvement Grants in the 2018-19 financial year.
