7. Brief details of project:

The Foulridge MUGA site is located in an area of public open space and is overlooked by a number of properties in the local community. Not all people can access the area even when help is at hand.

<u>Create a new access path to allow all people entry including disabled and wheelchair</u> <u>users.</u>

Create new accessible path 10 m x 1.5 m

Raise levels by 300mm with hardcore

Fit drainage pipes to avoid flooding

Lay tarmac surface (not a fall risk area)

Cost estimate: £2000

Install new swing basket equipment. The current one has a life expectancy of less than 6 months.

Supply and fit a new swing basket seat

Fit new timber crossbar to swing frame

Cost estimate: £1000

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Install new Bumble Bee Spring Seesaw.

Purchase new Seesaw from Active Garden Company.

Prepare ground for siting new Seesaw

Install and secure

Cost estimate: £1500

Install new impact surface underneath cable runway equipment to help protect against injury from falling.

Remove old grass matrix mats

Undertake remedial work at ground level in preparation for new mats

Fit new absorbing mats along prepared length under runway(zipslide)

Cost estimate: £1000

<u>Replace one ageing multi user station with a modern and more useable station for</u> various age groups.

Further to inquiries with various manufacturers including Spiel Art, Berlner Seil Fabrik, Active Toy, Alibaba, AMV and Wickentoys purchase a station which includes a climbing frame/slide.

Remove old activity station

Install and secure new station

Cost Estimate: £4000

Final Inspection of all work

Cost estimate: £500

8. Main outcomes to be achieved:

All people, including disabled and wheelchair users, would have access to the games space.

The improved games spaces can be used by children of the local community to increase physical activity and health. They can also be used by the children's parents/grand parents for some relaxation during this period.

Ofsted states that these areas allow children to enjoy being active and doing different activities. Not all schools have good quality MUGA facilities and outdoor spaces. By having access to a well-equipped MUGA we can encourage children to be active while learning new skills, have healthier lifestyles and better chances in life. These facilities create better outdoor environments

A well-resourced MUGA provides a boost to the community providing a rare place for children to play and adults to commute. It allows the children to have more fun.

All children suffer from some degree of boredom, however, children benefit from activities in the fresh air helping them focus their attention better, it Improves health and well being and the development of movement competencies.
