From this portion £1,406 has been allocated leaving a balance of £7,074. At the October meeting it was proposed that members considered using this balance of £7,074 to fund a bid to be submitted to the November meeting on behalf of Councillor Ahmed.

Separate from this, £1,000 was allocated at the August meeting for backstreet lighting.
