(b) Future provision of grit bins

At the September meeting of this Committee, Members were advised that the 30 red grit bins currently in place in the Brierfield and Reedley area would need to be removed from the public highway if funding for future refills could not be identified.

It was agreed that a brought forward balance of £1,349 which was already allocated for this purpose could be used to fund one refill.

In addition, at the request of the Committee, Brierfield Town Council and Reedley Hallows Parish Council have been asked if they will take over the responsibility of funding future refills of the grit bins in their respective areas.

A response is awaited from Reedley Hallows Parish Council. Brieffield Town Council believe that the refilling of the red grit bins should remain the responsibility of Pendle Council and recommends that the matter be referred to the Council's Policy and Resources Committee for consideration.

The Committee may agree to this recommendation, but is reminded that the Policy and Resources Committee has recently refused a request to approve a supplementary estimate to retain the grit bins in Nelson.

10. Vacant Houses

Enc. The Housing, Health and Economic Development Services Manager submits the attached report which informs the Committee on the position regarding the management of vacant houses in Brieffield and Reedley.

11. Heyhead Park, Brierfield

Following the decision in August this year to introduce a Public Spaces Protection Order in the Massey Street area of Brieffield, officers were asked to monitor Heyhead Park for antisocial behaviour (ASB) incidents.

The Committee is advised that, from 1st August to 13th November, 2018 there has been very low numbers of reported ASB/nuisance, with just two incidents reported to the police.
