

Additional information for the John Bradley Playing Fields roof repairs CIF bid

The project would involve the replacement of both existing roofs with a new firestone rubber roofing system. This would provide a more suitable and leak proof roof which will extend the life of the roof by approximately 20 years and counteract any roof leak issues previously experienced.

In 2016, there was a major roof leak that affected the electrics and resulted in the collapse of two of the changing rooms ceilings. As a result, the changing rooms were out of operation for a month which affected organised junior football games. The cost to carry out the remedial works was significant.

We have, in the past, only been able to carry out minor repair works to both roofs due to a lack of budget but feel that it has got to a point now where investment is essential to ensure the health & safety of users and increase the longevity of the buildings.

Main Outcomes to be Achieved:

To improve the roofs on both buildings and ensure there are no further roof leak issues in the medium-long term.
