### 10. CAPITAL PROGRAMME 2019/20

The Housing, Health and Engineering Services Manager reported that the balance of the Committee's 2019/20 Capital Programme was £22,356, including the amount carried forward from 2018/19. Parish Councils had been invited to submit any new bids in time for consideration at the July meeting.

### 11. COMMUNITY INVESTMENT FUND

Members noted the allocations from the Community Investment Fund detailed on the agenda and, in particular, a bid from Councillor B. Newman to use his allocation towards the resurfacing of Fence play area. The table showed that former Cllr J. K. Starkie's allocation had not been spent but it was thought that this was not the case. The Chief Financial Officer said that she would check the situation and report back.

### 12. TRAFFIC LIASION MEETING

The minutes of the Traffic Liaison Meeting held on 28<sup>th</sup> February, 2019 were submitted for information.

At the last meeting Members discussed an issue with a lot of surface water around the Clough Springs development on Wheatley Lane Road in close proximity to the electricity substation. Following investigations it had been revealed that the excess water was due to a broken/blocked culvert under the road which County Council would attend to once the electrics on site had been completed.

### **RESOLVED**

That County Council be reminded about the issue of surface water around the Clough Springs development on Wheatley Lane Road and the broken/blocked culvert in need of repair.

### **REASON**

To ensure that essential repair work to the culvert under Wheatley Lane Road, Barrowford is not overlooked.

### 13. ENVIRONMENTAL CRIME

The Environmental Services Manager submitted a report on environmental crime in Barrowford and Western Parishes area for the period 1<sup>st</sup> January to 31<sup>st</sup> March 2019 along with the totals for 2018/19, which was noted.

### 14. PROBLEM SITES

The Planning, Economic Development and Regulatory Services Manager submitted a report on problem sites in Barrowford and Western Parishes. It was noted that the fencing around the Spen Brook Mill site had been secured. It was hoped that development would commence shortly In the meantime the site would be monitored.
