ANNEX 1 – Mandatory Conditions

ANNEX 1 - Mandatory Conditions

A1.
There will be no supply of alcohol -
A1.1
at a time when there is no Designated Premises Supervisor in respect of the Premises Licence, or
A1.2
at a time when the Designated Premises Supervisor does not hold a Personal Licence or his Personal Licence is suspended.

A2.
The supply of alcohol must be made or authorised by a person who holds a Personal Licence.

A3.
When a film is exhibited, admission of children to that part of the premises must be restricted in accordance with any recommendation made by the British Board of Film Classification or any successor body (BBFC) in relation to that film.

A3.1
Where no recommendation exists from the BBFC or the council notifies the club under section 20(3)(b) Licensing Act 2003 the admission of children will be restricted in accordance with any recommendation made by the Council.

The following conditions came into force on 6th April 2010

A4.
(1)
The responsible person shall take all reasonable steps to ensure that staff on relevant premises do not carry out, arrange or participate in any irresponsible promotions in relation to the premises.

(2)
In this paragraph, an irresponsible promotion means any one or more of the following activities, or substantially similar activities, carried on for the purpose of encouraging the sale or supply of alcohol for consumption on the premises in a manner which carries a significant risk of leading or contributing to crime and disorder, prejudice to public safety, public nuisance, or harm to children -

(a)
games or other activities which require or encourage, or are designed to require or encourage, individuals to

(i)
drink a quantity of alcohol within a time limit (other than to drink alcohol sold or supplied on the premises before the cessation of the period in which the responsible person is authorised to sell or supply alcohol), or

(ii)
drink as much alcohol as possible (whether within a time limit or otherwise);

(b)
provision of unlimited or unspecified quantities of alcohol free or for a fixed or discounted fee to the public or to a group defined by a particular characteristic (other than any promotion or discount available to an individual in respect of alcohol for consumption at a table meal, as defined in section 159 of the Act);

(c)
provision of free or discounted alcohol or any other thing as a prize to encourage or reward the purchase and consumption of alcohol over a period of 24 hours or less;

(d)
provision of free or discounted alcohol in relation to the viewing on the premises of a sporting event, where that provision is dependent on -

(i)
the outcome of a race, competition or other event or process, or

(ii)
the likelihood of anything occurring or not occurring;

(e)
selling or supplying alcohol in association with promotional posters or flyers on, or in the vicinity of, the premises which can reasonably be considered to condone, encourage or glamorise anti-social behaviour or to refer to the effects of drunkenness in any favourable manner.

A5.
The responsible person shall ensure that no alcohol is dispensed directly by one person into the mouth of another (other than where

that other person is unable to drink without assistance by reason of a disability).

A6.

The responsible person shall ensure that free tap water is provided on request to customers where it is reasonably available.

The following conditions came into force on 1st October 2010

A7.

(1)

The premises licence holder or club premises certificate holder shall ensure that an age verification policy applies to the premises in relation to the sale or supply of alcohol.

(2)

The policy must require individuals who appear to the responsible person to be under 18 years of age (or such older age as may be specified in the policy) to produce on request, before being served alcohol, identification bearing their photograph, date of birth and a holographic mark.

A8.

The responsible person shall ensure that -

(a)

where any of the following alcoholic drinks is sold or supplied for consumption on the premises (other than alcoholic drinks sold or supplied having been made up in advance ready for sale or supply in a securely closed container) it is available to customers in the following measures -

(i) beer or cider: 1/2 pint;

(ii) gin, rum, vodka or whisky: 25 ml or 35 ml; and

(iii) still wine in a glass: 125 ml; and

(b)

customers are made aware of the availability of these measures.

ANNEX 2 – Conditions consistent with the Operating Schedule

B1. Prevention of Crime and Disorder

B1.1

The Designated Premises Supervisor or a responsible person nominated by him will be an active member of the local PubWatch Scheme.

B2. Public Safety

B2.1

The premises shall at all times be maintained so that all emergency escape routes and exits can be used at all times and without hindrance in the event of an evacuation of the premises.

B3. Prevention of Public Nuisance

B3.1

All doors and windows will be kept closed except for entrance and exit purposes when amplified live or recorded music is being played.

B3.2

A sign will be displayed in a prominent position where it can be readily seen by people leaving the premises and with lettering of such size that it can be easily read saying the following or something of similar effect:

"Please leave quietly without causing any noise or disturbance"

B3.3

When regulated entertainment is provided (excluding background recorded music) a public announcement will be made at the end of the evening asking customers to leave quietly.

B3.4

A noise inhibitor of an approved make will be installed in the premises and operated to restrict the sound of any regulated entertainment to a level agreed with the Council's Environmental Health and Urban Renewal Section.

B4. Protection of Children from Harm

B.4.1

Only children who are accompanied by responsible adults over the age of 18 shall be permitted in the premises.

B.4.2

Access by children to the premises is restricted in accordance with the terms of the Licensing Act 2003.

B.4.3

The age of children in these conditions is as defined by the relevant legislation.

B.4.4

Any person who looks or appears to be under the age of 21 will be asked to provide one of the following forms of identification to prove that they are over 18 years of age:

- UK photo driving licence
- Passport
- PASS Card (proof of age standards scheme)

Anyone unable to prove their age will be refused service.
