To Whom It May Concern,

I wish to raise my objection to the planning application that has been submitted by Colne Cricket Club.

I have lived in Horsfield Close for 19 years, when I bought the house I was familiar with the activities of the Cricket Club and was happy that the occasional noise from the club would be consistent with cricket matches the associated spectators.

During those 19 years there have been very occasional disturbances which have all been when the club has held evening functions/parties and open air football matches. During the World Cup they showed the game on a large screen and there were significant crowd disturbances which involved the use of mounted police.

Allowing the club to host open air events in a residential area will cause me significant distress, especially the idea of allowing music to be played late at night.

I am also concerned about allowing music to be played outside during the day without restriction. The club has hosted a school holiday club which is good for local people, but does this mean they will be allowed to play music loudly all day long?

The whole concept of creating an outdoor venue in a residential area is fundamentally flawed and should be rejected.
