21. APPLICATION FOR A PREMISES LICENCE UNDER THE LICENSING ACT 2003 117 REGENT STREET, NELSON

The Planning, Economic Development and Regulatory Services Manager submitted a report requesting consideration of an application for a Premises Licence at 117 Regent Street, Nelson. This was in response to representations received from Pendle Borough Council Licensing Service and Lancashire County Council Trading Standards.

The concerns raised were that it was believed that there could be possible links between the applicant and the previous owners/management of the premises which could result in repeat instances of illicit tobacco being sold. This gave rise to concern in relation to the prevention of crime and disorder licensing objective. The reason for this was that the applicant and the previous owners/management were registered as living at the same premises in Reedley. Although the applicant said he had lived in Burnley for the past two years.
