This matter was reported to the landowner, Lancashire County Council, who has installed some slit drainage connections to the culvert to intercept surface water and prevent runoff towards the adjacent highway and nearby properties. It is expected this will resolve the problem, but the Council's Engineers will continue to monitor the site to ensure the new system is working effectively.
