Under the Openness of Local Government Bodies Regulations 2014, people attending open meetings can film, audio record, take photographs or use social media. #### 1. <u>Declaration of Interests</u>

A Member must declare a disclosable pecuniary interest which he/she has in any item on the agenda. A Member with a disclosable pecuniary interest in any item may not participate in any discussion of the matter at the meeting and must not participate in any vote taken on the matter at the meeting.

In addition, the Council's Standing Orders require a Member with a disclosable pecuniary interest to leave the room where the meeting is held while any discussion or voting takes place.

Councillor N. McEvoy has allocated the remainder of his CIF funding of £1,540 to Blacko Parish Council towards the formation of a running track around the perimeter of a junior football pitch in the village.
