He advised Members that, a number of years ago, the area committee had supported a proposal to install bollards at this location. However, this option had not been pursued due to an objection from an emergency service. He asked if anything further could be done.	
	It was noted that a recent Community Investment Fund allocation of £1,040 had been made for the installation of bollards at this location, as reported at Minute 96. This proposal was currently being assessed.
