3. **Proposed Diversion Of Parts Of Public Footpaths Nelson 55** And 237 At Catlow Court, Southfield, Nelson

RESOLVED

- (1) That the Head of Legal Services be authorised to make a Ongoing public path order under Section 119 of the Highways Act 1980 to divert public footpaths Nelson 55 and 237, as illustrated in the map attached to the report in Appendix 2.
- (2) That if the order had been advertised and no objections received, or if any objections received were subsequently withdrawn, then the Head of Legal Services may confirm the orde as an unopposed order. (Subject to the proviso that any consent required for the removal of the hedge between points D and C had been obtained).
- (3)That if the order had been advertised and there were outstanding objections, the order and any objections received be sent to the Planning Inspectorate who, on behalf of the Secretary of State for the Department of Environment, Food and Rural Affairs, shall appoint an independent inspector to determine the order. (Subject to the same proviso in (2) above).
