Brierfield Premises Improvement Grants: 2019/20 Summary

PURPOSE OF REPORT

To update the Committee on the progress made on the Brieffield premises improvement grants Scheme in 2019/20 financial year.

RECOMMENDATIONS

- (1) That the Committee notes the summary of the premises improvement grant scheme.
- (2) That the Committee agrees to suggested allocation of an initial £3000 (Separate capital programme bid).

REASONS FOR RECOMMENDATIONS

- (1) To allow Members of the Committee to see the outcomes of the premises improvement grants scheme in the 2019/20 financial year.
- (2) To allow the Premises Improvement Grant programme to continue.

ISSUE

Premises Improvement grant scheme: Background

- 1) All business premises within the defined town centre boundary were eligible for a 50% grant up to a maximum of £3000, for improvements to their premises.
- 2) Premises improvement grants are promoted, targeted and administered by Economic Development staff. The Economic Development Team supports the applicants throughout the application process.

3) Having financial assistance available to businesses can be a contributing factor when making a decision on their business location. This could have a positive impact on vacancy rates in a town and help fill the current vacant properties.

Premises Improvement Grants 2019-20

- 1. It is requested that the Committee allocates sufficient funding in order to make decisions throughout the year to approve funding for premises improvement grants. An initial capital funding allocation of £3000 is suggested.
- 2. 3 grants were paid out in the last financial year of 2019-20 to a Travel agency £3000, a Community organisation £650 and a Hairdressers £1952.
- 3. All towns have been targeted though our digital newsletter in a recent promotion and the Economic Development team have received a number of enquiries for Brierfield.
- 4. In light of recent circumstances of Covid-19 we would request that the money is continued to be allocated to help Economic Development Team support our town centre shops
