4. APPLICATION FOR A PREMISES LICENCE UNDER THE LICENSING ACT 2003 – TOAST, 117B GISBURN ROAD, BARROWFORD

The Planning, Economic Development and Regulatory Services Manager submitted a report which asked members to consider an application for a Premises Licence following receipt of representations from a local resident.

<u>Licensing Committee</u> (13.07.2020 – 10.00 a.m.)

The application was from Mrs Leona Bannister who was also the proposed designated premises supervisor (DPS).

The Members and all relevant parties had received a copy of the report which included a copy of the application and the representations received.

The applicant and Mr Colin Myers, who had made representations, attended the hearing.

RESOLVED

That in respect of the premises licence application under the Licensing Act 2003 in respect of "Toast", 117B Gisburn Road, Barrowford, the application be granted subject to the conditions specified in the operating schedule and the following:-

- (1) The supply of alcohol shall cease at 23:00 Monday to Sunday
- (2) All recorded and live music shall cease at 23:00 Monday to Sunday

REASONS

- (a) It is considered that amendment to the hours for the supply of alcohol, live and recorded music serves to promote the prevention of the public nuisance objective.
- (b) Consideration has been given to all the powers available to the licensing authority under section 18 of the Act and concludes that modification of the hours on the licence is both necessary and proportionate in the circumstances.
